The Annual Report 2014-2015 will be presented to the meeting by Cr Allert after question time.

4. **GENERAL MEETING**:

Gabe Roberts asked the following questions:

Weed Control – Is there a program in place for public thoroughfares, who manages this? And how often do the weeds get sprayed.

CEO replied that the Manager Works Services Mr Peter Langan organises the spraying, and if various locations have been missed, feedback would be welcome.

Gabe stated that the entries into the township that some of the weeds were higher than a car.

CEO replied that the main entries into town were managed by Main Roads, as the Shire only looked after roads within and around the town. But would be happy to feed any information regarding roads to the Main Roads Department.

Removal of Car Bodies – Who is responsible? Can Shire enforce removal?

CEO replied that if the cars are on Main Roads, then it is their responsibility. If on Shire roads these can be stickered and then taken away.

Plans for a Coffee Shop – Looking for confirmation as whether there would be a coffee shop included as part of the new Interpretation Centre?

Cr Allert replied that – As part of the concept plan the Shire was looking at several things, including beautification of the river, as well as relocation of the library. There has been a public meeting held discussing various aspects of the concept plan.

CEO replied that he had nothing to add.

Petrol – Gabe asked whether there were any plans for petrol to be made available after 12:00pm on weekends.

Cr Allert replied that the Shire had done everything possible to try and get this happening, even approached the oil companies to get a slot petrol bowser same as the Shire of Wandering have. The oil companies are not interested as there are two service stations in the town. Also have approached owners of the service station with a view of some type of roster system. Also not interested in this.

Gabe asked whether this topic was documented somewhere. Cr Allert replied that the Manager of Economic Development possibly has got information recorded.
