This project received a huge boost recently, when the Dept. of Sport & Recreation approved a grant of \$610,000. It will be very powerful to now be able to say to potential grantors that we have State government backing.

Council will continue to work hard to obtain Royalties for Regions and other grants. All such grant applications stand more chance of success if it can be said that the community itself has 'put its money where its mouth is', by donating towards it. For example, the Shire of Corrigin's \$6.3m facility recently got off the ground partly due to community donations of \$175,000!

Our financial model allowed for contributions of up to \$100,000 by the general community.

All donations go directly to the ASF – the Council doesn't actually bank them, it just passes them onto the ASF. The Shire of Boddington will then be eligible for a discretionary ASF grant for this specific project.

The ASF was established by the Australian Government to assist organisations to raise funds through public and corporate donations for the development of sport in Australia. Pursuant to the ASF's listing in the Income Tax Assessment Act (1997) (div 30, S30-90), donations of \$2 or more to the ASF are tax deductible.

Donors must contribute unconditionally to the ASF to claim a tax deduction, however the ASF's structure makes it possible for a donor to nominate a registered project as the preferred beneficiary of their gift. The Shire of Boddington-Boddington Recreation & Community Centre, project no. 214065, is registered with and conducted under the charter of the ASF.

All claims are subject to being accepted by the Commissioner of Taxation. If either an individual or business is uncertain of their position, they should seek their own professional advice.
