

Interested in Casual Work?



Each year, Council needs traffic management at road works sites throughout the shire. As the work is intermittent, it doesn't pay to have qualified staff engaged full time and consequently we engage contractors from out of town.

Council has determined to make subsidised training available to Boddington Shire residents to become qualified Traffic Controllers.

The 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ day course will be run on 25 to 27 September 2019. 7:30 AM start, 4 PM finish days one and two and lunchtime finish on day three. Lunch, morning and afternoon tea will be provided each day.

The cost is normally \$600 plus GST. To encourage Boddington residents undertake the training, those resident in the Shire will be able to undertake the course for \$200 plus GST. Any resident who accepts more than 16 hours casual work in the 12 months subsequent to the course will have their attendance fee refunded.

Participants are limited to a maximum of 12, first in best dressed. Council has offered this course to neighbouring shires and there has been quite a deal of interest already.

If you live just outside the Shire, you will still be able to undertake the course at the normal cost and register for casual work, however there will be no reimbursement of your course fees.
