

2022 Overflow Camping

Terms and Conditions

The following requirements have been put in place to ensure that everyone is afforded the same respect and courtesy when staying in the overflow camping area.

- Sites will be available **after 2pm Friday**, Unfortunately there is no capacity for early check in. Departure by 10am Sunday. Maps will be sent in separate emails.
- Site Camping Permits are to be clearly displayed on vehicle windscreens at all times
- Please camp only in your designated site
- Limit of 4 – 6 people per site (4 adults or 2 adults & children from the same family)
- Camping is only permitted for Friday and Saturday nights
- Speed limit in the overflow camping area is 5 km/h
- No alcohol is permitted
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times – please pick up after them (please note that dogs are not permitted to enter the event grounds, service dogs accepted.)
- Rubbish is to be removed and disposed of in bins provided (additional bins are located throughout town)
- Noise to be kept to a minimum between 10pm and 7am
- A dump point is located on the corner of Johnstone St and Farmers Ave

The following items are not permitted in the overflow camping area:

- Fires
- Glass
- Generators
- Alcohol
