
Strategic Community Plan

Shire Grant Opportunities

The Shire of Boddington provides support to local businesses and community groups with a number of funding opportunities to assist them achieve their goals and deliver benefit for the wider community.

Business Assistance Grant provides financial assistance for local businesses to deliver projects that will result in economic benefit for their business. Applications are accepted ongoing.

Community Grants Program (formerly LOAF) provides financial assistance to incorporated bodies to deliver projects and programs which deliver benefit to the local community and local economy to build an engaged, vibrant, inclusive and healthy community. Round 3 applications close Thursday, 31 March at 4pm.

Community Facility Fund The Community Facility Fund assists community groups within the Shire of Boddington to upgrade, extend or construct sport, recreation and community facilities with strong whole of community benefit. 2022-23 applications close on Thursday, 29 April at 4pm.

Extended Trading Hours Survey now open

Retail trading hours provide times when retailers in Western Australia can open for business. All shops are regarded as general retail shops unless they fall under any one of the other categories including: small retail shops, special retail shops, filling - service stations or motor vehicle shops. In some cases the type of business can determine the hours which the business can be open to customers. For example:

- Small retail shops can trade 24 hours a day, every day of the year.
- Special retail shops are considered necessary for emergency, convenience or recreation goods. Shops in this category can trade between 6.00am to 11:30pm every day of the year.

Currently there are retail businesses within Boddington which don't fit either these two categories, so they are classified as a general retail shop. The current trading hours for a general retail shop is as follows:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday	8am – 6pm
Thursday	8am – 9pm
Saturday	8am – 5pm
Sunday	Closed

About the survey

The Shire of Boddington wishes to understand the level of community support for extending the current retail trading hours approved for general retail shops. The results from the survey will be collated in a report for Council to determine the need to pursue an application for a permanent extension to trading hours with the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety, as well as be used to inform future economic development projects and initiatives.

If extended trading hours are approved by the Department, businesses classified as a general retail shop will have the choice whether to open or not. The proposed extension to trading hours for a general retail shop is as follows:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday	8am – 9pm
Thursday	8am – 9pm
Saturday	8am – 5pm
Sunday	8am – 5pm




Join us at Hotham Park for Easter Storytime with a visit from a special quest.
