### Funding announced

New town centres, river upgrades and a boost for small business are among the 17 SuperTowns projects receiving \$80 million in funding.

Regional Development Minister Brendan Grylls announced the Royalties for Regions funding saying all nine SuperTowns will share the funding, which will not only improve services and amenities in the towns but provide a catalyst for future growth and investment.



### Boddington town and business growth

More than \$2.4 million is being invested to expand housing and small business development in Boddington.

Some \$1.25 million is being spent on new infrastructure to open up residential land, improving housing and rental affordability, and attracting more mining workers and their families to settle in the town.

Another \$1.2 million is being used for support for small business and training – helping to unleash a largely untapped tourism market and other emerging industries.
